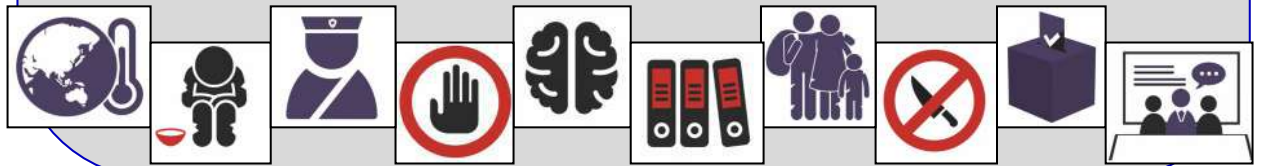
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Northgate Make their Mark



At the end of September during PART lesson, students from all year groups were able to vote in the UK Youth Parliament 'Make Your Mark' campaign. It is a consultation about 10 issues that affect young people. The issues that receive the most votes will be debated by members of the UK Youth Parliament in the House of Commons with the top issue becoming the UK Youth Parliament's campaign for next year.

There were lots of discussions about the issues concerned during PART lesson. In total 86% of students voted with the top UK issue for Northgate with 50% of the votes being 'protect the environment'. The top devolved issue with 35% of the votes was 'put an end to knife crime'. There were a number of local issues raised including the litter problem, not enough places for young people to go, reducing speed limits in certain areas, more job opportunities for young people and free bus tickets for under 18s along with others.



House Competition

In our celebration assemblies before half term a number of new House Captains were presented with their house ties - we wish them luck in their roles and hope they can inspire those in their teams to take part in the various competitions. Attenborough have taken an early lead with points already awarded from a Science competition, merits and House tokens.
