Year 7 Microclimate Fieldwork

Hailey and Seren from 7 Integrity told us about their recent Geography fieldwork. 'One Friday we went outside to four different places to take some temperature and wind speed measurements to collect microclimate data. We started at a covered area. We were in groups of up to four. Clipboards and anemometers were taken to collect and record the data. Once we had all the data we needed, we moved to another location.'

'The next place was the tennis courts and, in our groups, we took more measurements. The third location was the middle of the field. We went here because it is completely out in the open. The final location was the trees on the field. Measurements were taken again and we went back to class.'

'In class, we collected all of the data and found the averages. We recorded our data in tables and graphs and finally the class concluded and evaluated the results.'

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Northgate Computing Ambassadors

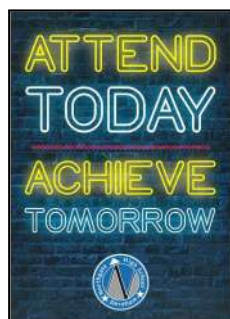

Mathematicians take on the Parallelogram Challenge

Some of our top Mathematicians in Years 8 to 10 have been competing in a weekly Maths challenge online – called the Parallelogram Challenge, created by Simon Singh (author of *The Simpsons and their Mathematical Secrets*). The challenges contain interesting, fun and challenging material that goes beyond school maths: mystery and history, activities and oddities, puzzles and problems.

The challenges have so far included paradoxes, history, videos, songs, online articles, online lectures, deep maths, weird maths, funny maths and maths in the headlines. Students complete the challenges in their own time and earn points depending on their percentage score on each Parallelogram, which in turn earns them mathematical badges. Each week in school we create a leader board and merits are assigned. We have been impressed by the commitment, determination and progress shown by all of those taking part (too many to mention altogether).
