

# Adverbs

Reminder: Adverbs are words that describe verbs, adjectives and other adverbs.

They tell us *how*, *when*, *to what extent*, and *why*.

Beautifully	Worriedly	Lazily	Urgently
-------------	-----------	--------	----------

Patiently	Cheerfully	Gently	Hungrily
-----------	------------	--------	----------

Quickly	Frequently	Annually	Noisily
---------	------------	----------	---------

Probably	Nobly	Attentively	Predictably
----------	-------	-------------	-------------

Steadily	Feebly	Leisurely	Loyally
----------	--------	-----------	---------

Bitterly	Harshly	Patiently	Suitably
----------	---------	-----------	----------

Immediately	Awkwardly	Scornfully	Brutally
-------------	-----------	------------	----------

Easily	Heavily	Equally	Rarely
--------	---------	---------	--------

Eagerly	Carefully	Gracefully	Unevenly
---------	-----------	------------	----------

Sloppily	Happily	Extremely	Badly
----------	---------	-----------	-------

Recklessly	Terribly	Stylishly	Grimly
------------	----------	-----------	--------

Remember: Adverbs do not always end in 'ly'.

Here are some examples that don't:

Soon	Worse	Much	Well
------	-------	------	------

Better	Too	Very	More
--------	-----	------	------

Quite	Not	Rather	Best
