### 'Bottle Free Friday' - a School Council Initiative

Our Environment Team and School Council members are always looking at how the school can be more environmentally friendly and have worked closely with Edwards & Blake in recent months to reduce the amount of plastic in Café North. They have introduced plastic-free alternatives to cutlery and packaging however in a recent meeting with Mrs Galley and Dr Hone, students expressed an interest to go a step further.



A meeting was arranged with Edwards & Blake to look at the possibility of reducing the number of plastic bottles sold in Café North. Bonnie, Jimmy and Abby completed a number of tasks set by the team at Edwards & Blake to look at average sales of the various drink options and how much Café North would lose in earnings if they went bottle-free once a week. As a result of their calculations, we can reveal that over the course of a year over 8700 fewer bottles would be sold, many of which are used just once and thrown away.

To compensate for loss of earnings, they calculated the small cost increase of some of the food items sold in Café North. The team wrote a [letter](#) to explain their plan to parents/carers and staff, as well as creating posters and posts for our social media (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram).

'Bottle Free Friday' will start on our return in January when no bottled drinks, cartons or cans will be sold in Café North on Fridays. Instead, students will need to bring in reusable bottles which they can fill up water from the water fountains or squash for 25p for a 500ml bottle in Café North. We believe that in time this will also make students think about buying bottled drinks, whether this be in school or out and about, and being more environmentally aware of their actions. We are also aiming to sell more of our plain

or Northgate logo reusable water bottles - available on Parent Pay for just £1.40.

We hope parents, students and staff can support this scheme in helping Northgate become more environmentally friendly, something our students feel passionately about and have worked so hard on.
