Bottle Free Friday - Re-launch

Members of our Earth Summit Team and School Council are pleased to be re-launching 'Bottle Free Friday' in January. As a school, we are always looking for ways to reduce plastic and this is something that everyone can play a part in. After meeting with Alan, our Café North Manager, it was agreed that the initiative, first launched in January 2020, would be re-introduced in 2022.

The scheme sees students and staff encouraged to bring their own reusable bottles to school, as many of those sold in Café North end up being thrown away. Over the course of a year, by holding 'Bottle Free Friday', it has been estimated that we could save about 8700 bottles from being sold and thrown in the bin. A [letter](#) has been sent to parents with an update and we will be reminding students and staff in PART lesson and across our social media.

'Bottle Free Friday' will start on our return in January where no bottled drinks or cartons will be sold in Café North on Fridays. Instead, students will need to bring reusable bottles which they can fill with water from the water fountains or they can buy squash for 25p for a 500ml bottle in Café North. Many students and staff already bring their own reusable bottles to school, which is great! We believe that in time, this will also make students think about buying bottled drinks, whether this be in school or out and about, and being more environmentally aware of their actions. We also have our own 500ml Northgate water bottles (plain or with the school logo) for sale via parent pay for just £1.40 or available for 30 merits.

We hope parents, students and staff can support this scheme in helping Northgate become even more environmentally friendly, something so many of our students and staff feel passionately about.

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Books2Africa


Books2Africa

Last half term, the Head Student Team, along with Mrs Sutcliffe, introduced a project called Books2Africa in assemblies. Books2Africa are a charity that donate books, CDs and stationery to schools and children in Africa. The Head Student Team said, 'We have been inspired to help, as it boosts other children's literacy skills, knowledge and gives them the opportunity to enjoy books in a safe learning environment'. As well as donating, Northgate students can become representatives for their form and year group. These representatives help and organise fundraisers, spread awareness and collect books for their forms/year group. If anyone has any suitable books, CDs or stationery, these can be brought into school and will be passed on.

Merit Update

In December we saw students pass the 30,000 merit mark and during the holidays a huge number of bonus merits were awarded (513 for those with >95% attendance for the second Autumn half term, 1185 for those with 100% attendance and 2180 for those gaining no negatives). Merit certificates have been given out by Heads of Year and we have also seen the first 100 merit badges awarded - well done!
