Website of the Month

What is Duo Lingo? You can sign up on a computer or phone, and it takes you through daily activities to learn the basics of different languages. Starting with the basics, with important words such as *I*, the, in, a, my, some... Duo Lingo will increase your fluency and accuracy with 5 to 10 minutes' work a day. It develops you abulary and grammar as well as read



minutes' work a day. It develops vocabulary and grammar as well as reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. If you don't keep up, it will send you a reminder!
