We will again be attending the festival this year during the morning of Wednesday 9th March 2022.

The Norfolk Careers and Skills Festival is a unique opportunity to get Year 10 pupils inspired for their future. This event is perfect for anyone aged 14-24 to discover the huge range of career opportunities that are available within the county. All pupils from Year 10 will be expected to attend this event and I have included an itinerary below. There is no cost to parents or pupils for this trip. **Pupils must wear full school uniform.**

Itinerary:

- Pupils will go to the main hall at the end of period 1.
- Pupils will be registered and then organised onto coaches for transport to The Showground. Departing at 9.50.
- Pupils will be allowed to move around the exhibition in groups of no less than 3 with remote supervision from staff
- Pupils will be given a strict time to return to the meeting point, ready for departure.
- Pupils will return to Northgate for 12.10pm, PART, lunch and afternoon lessons as normal.

If you **do not** wish your child to participate in this trip, please contact the school stating your reasons. In this circumstance, your child will be expected to remain in school and alternative arrangements made for him or her to continue normal timetabled lessons.
